**Confirmation:** Next Saturday we welcome Bishop Smith who will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at 11 am and 3.00 pm. We congratulate the Girls and Boys who will make their Confirmation and we thank the parents and teachers who have prepared them for the Sacrament. The Ceremony is more prayerful when videos and cameras are used only when the Ceremony is finished.

When we welcome the Holy Spirit into our hearts and allow him to act, Christ makes himself present in us and takes shape in our lives; through us, it will be he — Christ himself — who prays, forgives, gives hope and consolation, serves the brethren, draws close to the needy and to the least, creates community and sows peace. Think how important this is: by means of the Holy Spirit, Christ himself comes to do all this among us and for us. That is why it is important that children and young people receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

**Eucharistic Adoration** takes place every Tuesday and Friday from after 9 am Mass until 8 pm. We are always looking for new volunteers to add to the existing rota. We are very lucky in Dunboyne to have about 50 committed people who volunteer for this spiritual exercise. Ideally we would like to have 3 people for each hour. It is a great reflection on the people of Dunboyne, who have given of their time and kept the adoration going for nearly 30 years. In this year of Mercy, we would encourage you to volunteer an hour and perhaps you might invite a friend also to give an hour. If you yourself or you know somebody who is willing to commit to an hour you could ask them to contact the Parish Office and we would only be too happy to facilitate them with an hour that would suit. Dedicating one hour a week may seem a huge commitment to some but it is really not as demanding as it might seem. It is so important in the present time that people pray for peace in the world, for families and vocations to the priesthood. Eucharistic Adoration provides us with a wonderful opportunity for doing this. The blessings from Eucharistic Adoration on individuals, their families and the community are immeasurable.
