Apostolic Nuncio Archbishop Charles Brown opened the Holy Door of Mercy at St Patrick's Basilica, Lough Derg to inaugurate the Jubilee of Mercy pilgrimage season. Lough Derg Prior, Fr Owen McEneaney, said the island shrine was a sacred space of mercy and everyone was invited to *"Come and let God's mercy find you on Lough Derg. During 2016, I invite pilgrims into a new commitment: if you are seeking time out from the daily grind of the everyday to come and walk in the footsteps of our forebears. Lough Derg reaches out to those in need: whatever your creed, background, personal circumstances or religious practice, everyone is most welcome.
