Saint Benedict of Norcia. Memorial Day: 11th July. Founder of the Benedictine Order and famous monastery in Monte Cassino. Wrote his Rule as guidance for those who lived in monastic life. His rule is associated with the idiom "*ora et labora*" – (pray and work), seen as the basic instruction for monastic life.

Rule of St. Benedict: *This is the kind of zeal then which monks should exercise with fervent love, that is, 'let them be eager to show honour to one another'; let them bear patiently their infirmities whether of body or character; let them vie with one another in mutual obedience; let no one follow what he judges advantageous for himself but rather for another; let them love the brotherhood in all chastity; let them fear God in love; let them prefer nothing whatever to Christ, and may he lead us all alike to everlasting life.*

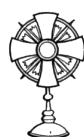
