Sculpting our lives in the God's image by revealing the divine beauty within us:

A sculptor once said: "Many people imagine that a sculptor looks at a piece of stone, of marble and thinks what he could project into it and carves it, getting rid of all that does not correspond to his vision. This," he went on to say, "is not the case. A real sculptor is one who looks at the material and, looking at it, gradually or suddenly discovers what is hidden within it, and proceeds to disengage the beauty from everything that prevents us, an him, from seeing it. In other words, the statue is already inside the material, the beauty is already there; and the purpose of the exercise is to free it from what separate us from it." This coincides with a saying of St Ephrem the Syrian: "When God calls a human being into existence, He puts at the very core of his being all the kingdom of God, and the purpose of life is to dig, to dig incessantly, to dig carefully, to dig with hope and with joy until we come to this hidden treasure and become one with it."
