PRAYING FOR THE DEAD AND THE LIST OF THE DEAD: Traditionally November is the month for commemorating our dead. In doing so we follow the sacred tradition since the earliest days of the Christian community to remember the dead at the Altar. That is why Catholics have a venerable tradition of having Masses offered for the souls of the departed. All Souls Day (2nd November) and the whole month of November are traditionally devoted to the Holy Souls. We do not live alone, we do not sin alone and we are not saved alone. Our lives are intertwined, spill into one another's, for better or worse. My prayer for another is not something external to him or her even after death; in the interconnectedness of being, my prayer can play a part in the purification of the other. During the month of November and on the First Friday of the month, Mass will be offered for all those who have been included on the list. Please use the sheets and the envelope marked "List of the Dead" provided in the porches of the Churches or simply use any envelope and write "List of the Dead" on it. Place your list, together with your donation in the steel boxes in our churches.
