When Jesus reinterprets the story of Moses for the Sadducees, he says that when God told Moses, "I AM the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob," God was speaking of the great patriarchs as alive rather than dead. Jesus then reminds the Sadducees that not one of God's -beloved children is dead, but to God, "all are alive." To this, the scribes praise Jesus, saying, "Teacher, you have spoken well" (*Luke 20:38-39*). This week, may we meditate on the reality of God's love that breaks down the barriers between life and death, and the promise that far beyond this life, "all are alive."
