The Ceremony is more prayerful when videos and cameras are used only when the Ceremony is finished.

When we welcome the Holy Spirit into our hearts and allow him to act, Christ makes himself present in us and takes shape in our lives; through us, it will be he — Christ himself — who prays, forgives, gives hope and consolation, serves the brethren, draws close to the needy and to the least, creates community and sows peace. Think how important this is: by means of the Holy Spirit, Christ himself comes to do all this among us and for us. That is why it is important that children and young people receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The unity among ourselves which we celebrate in the Eucharist is not just our shared interests, our belonging to the same neighbourhood, even our common humanity. It is, more fundamentally, our communion with God through Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit.

The more we understand the meaning of that unity, the more we see other human beings as brothers and sisters. We recognise that our sharing in the eternal banquet, which the Eucharist foreshadows, depends on our treatment of all the sons and daughters of God. The union with God for which we hope is a union that we can only enter if we are willing to share it with all who are called by God.
