The school of the Holy Spirit is a school of simplicity

The Church must also see itself as part of the real communion of the People of God. We are not alone. We belong to a people created by God's positive initiative in society and in human history. This people is animated by the Holy Spirit but it is animated according to the structure given to them by God and according to the vocation or mission which the Spirit never ceases to evoke in the Church: consequently, we are to be attentive to each other, taking each other into account in a living, intelligent, and critical awareness of what each one is. ... This means, on the part of the faithful, an openness towards the teaching of the pastors, but on the other hand, on the part of pastors, a faith-filled, simple openness to that which God invites them to understand through the events of history and through the faithful. The school of the Holy Spirit is a school of simplicity; it is not a facile school nor one of simplification.
