**Trocaire National Church Collection** will take place on 22/23 July in all dioceses in aid of 25million people facing hunger crisis in east-Africa: Kenya, South Sudan, Somalia and Ethiopia. The two most severely affected areas of Kenya are Kitui (east of Nairobi) and Turkana (north-east Kenya bordering Somalia). The first Bishop of Kitui was Bishop William Dunne of Delvin and the first Bishop of Lodwar (Turkana) was Bishop John Mahon of Killeigh-Tullamore. Kiltegan priests ministered in both dioceses. Irish Loreto Sisters are present in South Sudan.

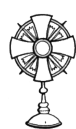

**The Temptation to Reduce God To Our Own Level.** St Augustine's cryptic statement in that regard is hard to surpass: "If you understand, it is not God. If you are able to understand, you understand something other than God" (*Saint Augustine, Sermon 52, 16, Migne PL 38*). Inspired by St Augustine, Pope Francis, in his first major interview in 2013, commented as follows: "In this quest to seek and find God in all things there is still an area of uncertainty. There must be, if a person says that he met God with total certainty and is not touched by a margin of uncertainty, then this is not good. For me, this is an important key. If one has the answers to all the questions – that is the proof that God is not with him" (*Interview with Pope Francis, 30<sup>th</sup> September 2013*).
