Thursday 14th September, Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross:

'That the death of God involves the death of Man, along with the birth of a new form of humanity is orthodox Christian doctrine. The death of God ...shatters the idolatrous view of Yahweh as irascible despot and shows him up instead as vulnerable flesh and blood.'
