The Voice of God Within

"At times in the discussions about new and complex moral problems, it can seem that Christian morality is in itself too demanding, difficult to understand, and almost impossible to practice. This is untrue, since Christian morality consists in the simplicity of its Gospel: that of following Jesus Christ, of abandoning ourselves to Him, and of letting ourselves be transformed by His grace and renewed by His mercy—gifts that come to us in the living communion of His Church.

We must ask ourselves: why do so many acquiesce in attitudes and behaviors that offend human dignity and disfigure the Image of God in us? The normal thing would be for conscience to point out the mortal danger to the individual and to humanity contained in the easy acceptance of evil and sin. Is it because conscience itself is losing the ability to distinguish good from evil?

In a technological culture in which people are used to dominating matter—discovering its laws and mechanisms in order to transform it according to their wishes—the danger arises of also wanting to manipulate conscience and its demands. . . . Conscience is the most secret core and sanctuary of a person, where we are alone with God. In the depths of our conscience, we detect the moral law, which does not impose itself upon us, but which holds us to a higher obedience. This law is not an external human law, but the voice of God, calling us to free ourselves from the grip of evil desires and sin, and stimulating us to seek what is good and true in life."
