In the Autumn 2017 General meeting of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference the Bishops noted that the Joint Oireachtas Committee on the **Eighth Amendment** of the Constitution is currently considering the report of the Citizens' Assembly. Bishops reiterated key themes from their submission to the Citizens' Assembly, namely: that human life begins at conception; that the life of the unborn baby is *equal* to that of her/his mother; and, that the right to life is *the* fundamental human right antecedent to all other human rights.
