They follow the Church’s safeguarding policy, available at www.meahsafteguading.ie and, as part of the process of implementing this policy, there is in place various procedures which many of the congregation may be familiar with. These include codes of behaviours for the children and adults involved in parish activities, consent forms which parents and children must sign before they participate in activities, adequate supervision and good recruitment practices, including Garda vetting. The parish representatives, together with the priests of the parish, have received training and ongoing support in this work. Likewise you can find contact details for the Designated Liaison Person, who refers any concerns and complaints to the relevant authorities.

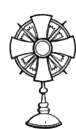
