Pope Francis wants you to stop bringing your phone to Mass

“The Mass is not a show, but a beautiful, transformative encounter with the true loving presence of Christ.” Pope Francis said.

That is why people need to focus their hearts on God, not focus their mobile phone for pictures during Mass.

When the priest celebrating Mass says, "Let us lift up our hearts," he is not saying, "lift up our mobile phones" and take a picture. No. It's an awful thing" to do, the pope said on 8th November during his weekly general audience in St. Peter's Square.

"It makes me so sad when I celebrate (Mass) in the square or in the basilica and I see so many mobile phones in the air. And not just by the lay faithful, some priests and bishops, too," he said.

"Please, Mass is not a show. It is going to encounter the Passion, the resurrection of the Lord," he said to applause.

The pope's remarks were part of a new series of audience talks on the Mass. The series, he said, should help people understand the true value and significance of the liturgy as an essential part of growing closer to God.
